

Freezing Temperatures for Some Fruit, Nut & Oil Plants

- a. These are "ball park" figures given for older plants. Flowers and fruit, smaller branches and newer plants freeze earlier.
 b. More damage occurs if plant is at these temperatures for more than a short time and if it is the first frost of the year.
 c. Freezing temperatures may vary due to weather conditions and plant variety.
